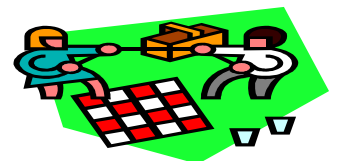
The Panther Pride placed 50<sup>th</sup> out of 85!
